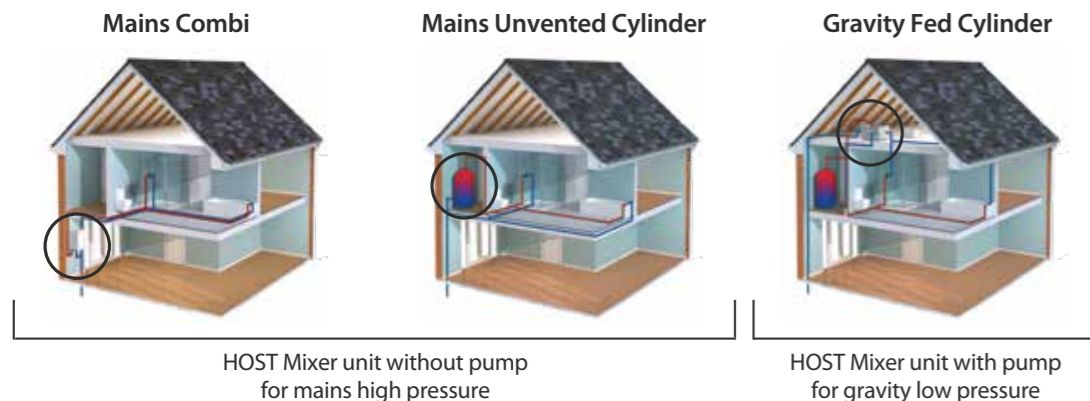

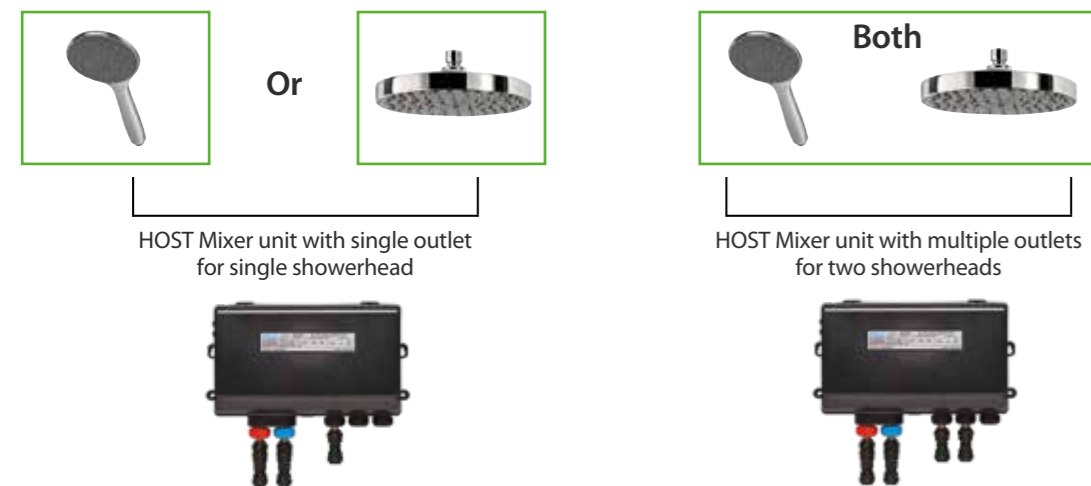
Plan & locate

Just follow these simple steps

STEP 1: Know your hot water system



STEP 2: Decide how many outlets you would like



STEP 3: Agree on where to put the mixer box

Choose the location of your mixer box.

STEP 4: Choose the accessories for your selected outlet(s)

Installing the HOST

Example shown is of the mixer box in the loft:

- The through the ceiling riser rail allows pipe to be routed to the loft
- This can be combined with a through the ceiling fixed head
- Only the mixed water outlet pipes needs routing to the shower area
- Connect pipe to the supplied push-fit fitting
- The performance is optimised for combi boilers by fitting the supplied flow restrictor
- The mixer unit can be connected to the control using the 10 meter cable supplied
- The control cable plugs into the shower controller
- Alternatively the shower controller can be wireless, powered by three AA batteries
